

1 Resolution to Develop Facilities Master Plan

6 WHEREAS, after the 2009 November Voter's Meeting, a Building/Facility Needs Committee (BFNC) was formed  
7 to research and address the future facility needs of Trinity Lutheran Church; and  
8

9 WHEREAS, the BFNC has met regularly and surveyed the congregation about building shortcomings; and  
10

11 WHEREAS, the BFNC has efficiently addressed several minor facility needs; and  
12

13 WHEREAS, a Facilities Master Plan is an effective tool for planning future building needs; and  
14

15 WHEREAS, a Facilities Master Plan can aid in communicating future ministry direction; and  
16

17 WHEREAS, the BFNC recommends the major facility needs identified are best addressed by the services of an  
18 architect in developing a Facilities Master Plan; and

20 WHEREAS, the BFNC has met with and interviewed representatives from five different architectural firms; and  
21

22 WHEREAS, the members of Trinity had plans to address the challenges of our current facility in the 1980's; and

24 WHEREAS, the blueprints and building improvement phases from the work of previous building committees have  
25 been lost; and

27 WHEREAS, the newest parts of our current facility were constructed over 45 years ago (1966/1967) as part of the  
28 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the congregation; and

30 RESOLVED, the members Trinity Lutheran Church continue to improve its ministry site through the development  
31 of a Facilities Master Plan, and be it further  
32

33 RESOLVED, Gazelle, Lewis, and Associates of Flint be contracted at an expense not to exceed \$14,000 to develop  
34 a Facilities Master Plan for Trinity Lutheran Church; and be it further  
35

36 RESOLVED, \$14,000 be released from the Koester Estate Funds to pay for the Facilities Master Plan; and be it

39 RESOLVED, the members of Trinity Lutheran Church be encouraged to seek out ways to continue to maintain and  
40 improve the current facilities so that Trinity Lutheran Church will be a place where lives are changed with  
41 the Gospel of Jesus Christ.
